

## Successful start



#### **Kick-off Precise**

In April, we organized the Kickoff of our project in Sønderborg. We had the pleasure to welcome all PRECISE partners, and also some network partners. We reviewed all the tasks and plans

and defined the necessary working groups. The project structure and tasks were presented and aligned for optimum task completion. Interreg secretariat introduced an overview of applicable rules. We can already feel an amazing synergy and motivation between the partners, who will contribute with their expertise to the achievement of a PRECISE tool for expiration dates of meat/fish. During the kick-off, the device was tested on a piece of meat whose expiration date has just passed. The sensor demonstrated that the piece was still safe for consumption. During the project, the sensor will be tested with meat/fish with known expiration dates (via sensorial and other laboratory tests), and the sensor will learn to correlate the readings with the correct expiration dates.



### Assembly of electronic noses for testing

Roana visited our partners at ISIT in Itzehoe. They delivered sensor chips to be optimized and integrated into electronic noses. The image shows Jana Meyer and Roana de Oliveira Hansen (left to right) holding sensors and Lars Blohm with a whole wafer of sensors like they produce them at Fraunhofer ISIT.

The sensors are now assembled in the prototype by AmiNIC and will be delivered to our partners for testing.
